This week the last of more than 2800 Christmas shoebox gifts crossed safely into Mexico. That in itself is a miracle, as pastors are hassled every Tuesday when they go home with beans and rice. They must resort to driving miles out of their way to cross the big bridge at Zaragoza in hopes of getting a "green light" so they don't have to endure a shake down. It's the shoeboxes themselves, though, that are the real miracle!

By the end of November we'd received the requests from the pastors, but after all our groups delivered their boxes to us we found that we were 300 boxes short. Some deliveries were huge so we took the totals they gave as accurate, but as we began processing them to match what each pastor asked for, we discovered the numbers weren't coming out. We took inventory 4 different times and came up short every time. We were praying and discussing who would have to be dropped or shorted in their requests. We had people all through our network praying!

In faith, we kept working along with our volunteers. The night before our final work day, as we were getting ready to go home for the night, Elfi said let's count one more time. And the boxes were miraculously there! No last minute deliveries had come through the door, yet there they were! A real "loaves and fishes" miracle! There's no other explanation, because after 18 years we certainly know how to count boxes. Praise the Lord!

We can't wait to hear what other miracles will come as a result of these shoeboxes! And not just the boxes, but all the homemade blankets, new coats, jackets, and shoes that were donated will be amazing blessings to all who receive them.
