Faithful Friends

In 17 years, we've lived through enough experiences to fill a book with our faithful friends. Many of them, you walked through with us. The Lord has opened opportunities for us (Elfi & Joan) to travel more, visiting churches and individuals—especially our New Mexico friends in Cloudcroft, Mayhill, La Luz, and Weed. We've been able to sing & lead worship, and share what God has been doing along the border. We're very grateful for the many faithful friends the Lord has surrounded us and the ministry of CBM with. Whether we are here or traveling, we have confidence in our faithful friends to keep our Tuesday distribution day running smoothly.

Pastor Enrique and his wife Elena work behind the scenes every Monday evening with help from their boys. They set up the church fellowship hall for breaking down 50# sacks of beans & rice, as well as prepare the grocery bags for the pastors who will cross from Mexico the next day. Volunteers from our church and community show up every Tuesday at 9AM to break down the bulk beans & rice into zip bags for up to 400 families each week.

Everything that goes out with the pastors on Tuesdays is thanks in large part to our delivery network. John Dalton comes every other week with beans purchased through FBC Cloudcroft. Greg Beard and all the team of Grace of Giving can be counted on to deliver groceries and rice every month. George Hughes comes through once or twice each month with food and Bibles. Glen Meadows Baptist from San Angelo, TX brings meat, canned and boxed goods, and a variety of other supplies two to three times each year. The Murtlands bring donated items from their Bible study group at FBC El Paso throughout the month.

There are several Baptist Associations that work closely with us. Lamesa, Tri-County, and Double Mountain Associations are big promoters of our School Supply Kits and Christmas Shoebox Drives for kids. And Pittsburg Association comes every July to put on a great VBS in Fabens, sharing the good news about Jesus and His love for the 100 plus kids who attend. AND THERE ISN'T ROOM ENOUGH TO MENTION EVERYONE ELSE WHO COVERS CBM FINANCIALLY AND IN PRAYER! We are truly blessed with faithful friends!

We are so thankful for the home FBC Fabens offered us back in 2001. Our home church made it possible for CBM to organize and operate out of the church facilities. Through the years, we have watched as our church went through transition and change, yet remain faithful to its promise of providing CBM a home. Amazingly, we have witnessed people we once ministered to in Mexico cross over to escape the violence and become members of FBC Fabens. Even our own Pastor Enrique has known us from the beginning—he was the first pastor from Mexico we met, as he led the Fabens Spanish mission
