While we have had to divide our time between CBM operations and doctor appointments, our volunteers have kept the food distribution going with Luly's overseeing the process of packaging beans, rice, and groceries to distribute to the pastors when they come. None of us have lost sight of the purpose the Lord called us to so many years ago. Our partnership with the pastors and missionaries we minister to and through is not just about meeting physical necessities. It is bringing the light and love of Jesus Christ to a people in spiritual poverty.

Pastor Pablo Gonzalez preached this year's anniversary message. The scripture he used was **I Samuel 7:12**, "Thus far the Lord has helped us." Because of our long partnership, they were able to start BAN ministry to feed the school children in their community a number of years ago. Most of those kids are fortunate if they get one good meal a day. In his message he shared how "many may think a little beans and rice in a plastic grocery bag isn't much. But when we knock on a door and people peek through the window, that small sack is a gift that opens their door and also their hearts to the Lord. *Cruzando Fronteras* (Crossing Borders) has empowered pastors and churches to fulfill their God-called purpose, along the border and beyond."

So here we are, starting our 25th year as Crossing Borders Ministries. Some of you have been with us from the beginning and we have the pictures to prove it! Together we have blessed the heart of God by caring for those in need. Life remains difficult for the people living just across the Rio Grande in Mexico. In their villages they are constantly caught in the "crossfire" of the fluctuating migration situation, the ebb & flow of cartel violence, and their own levels of poverty. We help our pastor friends minister to the working poor, the widows, and the orphans.

Right now, financial gifts are down at CBM. Please pray with us for the Lord to "open the windows of Heaven." It may come through you, through lower food prices, or someone new to us. Our part is to ask, seek, and knock, and stand on I Samuel 7:12.

A Boy Called "Spoon"

Pastor Perea tells the story of a boy that used to come to church whenever they had a fellowship meal or at VBS. The ladies that cooked nicknamed him "Cuchara," spoon in Spanish. It was because he always ate with his hands, until they taught him to eat with utensils. As happens, time passed and people fled their village because of the border violence. They lost track of their little Cuchara.

One day last year, a young man came up to Pastor Perea and asked, "Pastor, do you remember me? It's me, Cuchara!" He got a US dollar bill out (about 20 pesos worth) and said he wanted to give back for the beans and rice he was always fed. He is a Christian and working part time, and thanked the Lord for their meeting.

Cuchara is just one of the many people who have been impacted by our commitment to minister in partnership with these dedicated pastors. Your prayers and support continue to help extend the love of Jesus to all the other "Cucharas" our pastors and missionaries come in contact with.
