Blessings Coming In and Going Out

It has been a busy summer! We started it off by playing guitars and singing in the Sacramento Mountains around the Cloudcroft area where Elfi grew up. The great folks of FBC Cloudcroft were the first to support Crossing Borders Ministries when we began in 2001. The Lord used us in many ways while we were there, opening doors to lead worship at a number of churches, an RV park, and a campground church retreat. Believe it or not, we even had the opportunity to play with a bluegrass group every week! We added to their mix with some old gospel songs, and were stretched musically by following them in true bluegrass fashion - playing on the 'fly' without written words or music. We even joined them to sing and play at a benefit for the Cloudcroft Pioneer Museum. Not sure they'd ever had gospel music there before!

We returned to Fabens in mid-July in time to meet with the mission teams working in our area, who were here to help conduct Vacation Bible Schools and work on building projects. Once again our friends from Lamesa helped two Spanish speaking churches with their VBS and supplied 3 churches in Mexico with crafts, decorations, and materials for their VBS as well. Next came the team from Oklahoma, who put together a wonderful VBS here in Fabens. Over 100 kids and adults were in 5 classes learning about how much God loves them! They also took a group into Mexico to help a VBS there and finish a construction project. In their 'spare time' they even changed some fluorescent fixtures for us in the church hall.

In the midst of that VBS week, we went to work on receiving school supply kits and collecting the names of needy children from the pastors. We were blessed to have the Keiths and Joani from Tri-County Association join us for the week following VBS. They worked at helping us sort, count, box up, re-count, & stage for shipping each day. They brought with them a load of donated medicines for a clinic in Mexico and new clothes purchased for distributing through our pastor network. They also helped us make lists of items needed to make more school kits with monies that were donated - then even shopped for all those supplies and helped us assemble them into kits!

After the last of the school kits left for Mexico, we tallied the numbers: **2100 kits** in all went to help children and teens go to school! Every year it's a miracle to watch how the lists of names the pastors give us are always filled. Many people don't realize that in Mexico, to buy all that's in one kit would take a working parent's paycheck for a week. Can you imagine trying to afford supplies for three or four children? We've learned over the years that these kits actually help families not have to choose which of their kids will

Showers of Blessing

Thank you, dear friends, for partnering with us to make an eternal difference in the lives of so many. *In the past 12 months we have:*

- Distributed over 70,000 pounds of beans & rice
- Fed as many as 350 families every week in 26 communities
- Worked alongside a network of 18 border pastors and missionaries along the 50 mile El Paso/Juarez Lower Valley
- Distributed 800 grocery sacks for our pastoral families, one each week, filled with everything from powdered milk to coffee, canned meats, and much more
- Empowered pastors in their ministries with 200 cases of complete Bibles in Spanish (RVR 1960) as well as evangelistic tracts & teaching materials
- Shipped out thousands of additional food cases such as fresh fruits & vegetables, dried beans, rice, flour, hot & cold cereals
- Sent out hundreds of boxes of medicines for the sick
- Sent out hundreds of nice coats & blankets during cold weather
- Sent over 2800 Christmas shoebox gifts to kids in Mexico last year
- Sent 2100 school supply kits to needy children & youth this year
- Supplied 4 feeding stations (comedors) for needy children
